**Title: Addressing challenges in child safety**

Children are disproportionately affected by injury, however most of these injuries could be prevented through effective prevention programs. To enable the effective adoption, implementation and monitoring of evidence-based interventions for child injury prevention strong leadership, effective management, and multi-sectoral coordination is required. This workshop will discuss lessons learnt, future directions, strategies to advance program delivery, and next steps for more effective leadership.

This workshop will provide the opportunity for participants to share their current child safety priority actions and explore the depths of injuries from button battery ingestion to road safety to drowning, burns, poisoning prevention, safe sleeping, safe play, safe homes and safe travel. It will look at system-based approaches, engineering solutions, community and parent engagement and much more.

UNICEF will be joining Kidsafe at the workshop to discuss their current work and future directions in child safety. We invite those who are interested in child safety to join us for an interactive workshop to share, explore, discuss and work on next steps for the prevention of injury to children.
